





Endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatogram (ERCP).



- An endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatogram (ERCP) is a test that combines the
 use of a flexible, lighted scope (endoscope) with X-ray pictures to examine the tube that
 drain the liver, gallbladder and pancreas.
- The endoscope is inserted through the mouth and gently moved down the throat into the esophagus, stomach and duodenum until it reaches the point where the ducts of the pancreas (pancreatic duct) and gallbladder (bile ducts) drain into the duodenum.
